## VACCINATION

Travellers travelling from countries at-risk of yellow fever infection (including transit) must provide an International Certificate of Vaccination or Prophylaxis or a Medical Letter of Exemption if the vaccine is contraindicated.

The certificate or exemption letter must be submitted together with the visa application form. The travelers have to present the certificate exemption letter to the immigration officer upon arrival at the port of entry to the Kingdom of Thailand.
